Notice of 2 Temporary Traffic Orders
Headington, Coopers Alley
Footpath 320/40 Closure, and
Beaumont & Trinity Roads - Prohibition of Waiting
Date of Order: 15 January 2018
Coming into force: 22 January 2018

These orders are being introduced because of retaining wall construction and resurfacing works which are anticipated to take 4 weeks to complete.

The effect of the orders is to (1) close temporarily Cooper's alley, Footpath 320/40 between Beaumont and Trinity Roads; and (2) to temporarily prohibit waiting in Beaumont Road between Coopers Alley and Coopers Place; in Trinity Road between Beaumont Road and Spring Lane; and in Quarry High Street between Nos. 24 & 36.

Exemptions are included for emergency services and for the works and for pedestrian access to premises which are only accessible from the closed section of footpath.

Appropriate signs will be displayed to indicate when the measures are in force.

The alternative route for pedestrians is via Quarry High Street, Beaumont Alley, Beaumont Road and vice versa.

This Order will remain in force for a maximum period of 6 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
